
## Storage & Car Transportation

## Rules & Regulations

- All cars must pass a 105dB static noise limit.
- Drivers and passengers must sign on and obtain a wristband to be allowed access on track.
- All drivers must attend a safety briefing at 08:30.  
[For late arrivals the second briefing will be at 09:30].
- Road cars must be MOT'd, racecars must have passed MSA scrutineering within the last year [We do not scrutineer cars therefore it is the responsibility of participants to ensure their car is in track worthy condition]
- All participants must wear a suitable crash helmet and have covered arms and legs and bring waterproof clothing in the event of rain.
- Slick tyres are permitted but only if the car has adequate roll protection.
- Passengers must be 16 years or older, if under 18 years old a parent or guardian must counter sign their disclaimer.  
[No children under 16 years of age are allowed in the pit lane].
- Hand held cameras cannot be used whilst out on track.
