

Rules & Regulations

- All cars must pass a 105dB static noise test.
- Drivers and passengers must sign on and obtain a wristband to be allowed access on track. All drivers must show a full UK driving license at sign-on.
- All drivers must attend a safety briefing at 08:30.
 (For late arrivals the second briefing will be at 09:30).
- Road cars must be MOT'd, racecars must have passed MSA scrutineering within the last year (We do not scrutineer cars therefore it is the responsibility of participants to ensure their car is in track worthy condition)
- All participants must wear a suitable crash helmet and have covered arms and legs and bring waterproof clothing in the event of rain.
- Slick tyres are permitted but only if the car has adequate roll protection.
- Passengers must be 16 years or older, if under 18 years old a parent or guardian must counter sign their disclaimer.
 (No children under 16 years of age are allowed in the pit lane).
- Hand held cameras cannot be used whilst out on track.
